



***Fabulett 1933 - A Queer Tale of In/Visibility:*** The critically acclaimed show returns to the **Edinburgh Festival Fringe** for a full run at **Underbelly Bristo Square**.

**Berlin, February 1933**, the new German leadership orders the closure of all ‘venues which promote immorality’. But Felix, the emcee of the depraved Fabulett, still has a story to tell. Set at the transition from one of the most liberal societies of its time with the **world’s first gay rights movement**, where the **first queer anthem** was composed, one of the **first gay themed movies** was made, and the **first gender affirming surgeries** were performed, to one of the biggest tragedies in human history, *Fabulett 1933* is a queer tale of in/visibility featuring **music, ideas and lives classified as ‘degenerate’ by the Nazis**.

Following its **critically acclaimed run at the 2022 Edinburgh Festival Fringe**, where the show was praised for its "nuanced recognition of the capacity even for certain LGBT people to enable authoritarianism, intentionally or inadvertently" (★★★★ The Scotsman) and "the clear relevance and applicability of the show’s message today, with the re-emergence of the far-right now being a threat to so many, in diverse and different places" (★★★★★ Edinburgh Guide), *Fabulett 1933* returns to Edinburgh for a full run at Underbelly Bristo Square.

*Fabulett 1933* is a one-person musical **written and performed by Michael Trauffer (he/him)**, under the **musical direction of James Hall (he/him)**. The **original story** is set around true events, and while the **original score** is composed by Trauffer, the show also **features English versions of songs by Mischa Spoliansky and Friedrich Hollaender**.
